








WORLD RED CROSS DAY




AWARENESS PROGRAM ON IPR









ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE AND MACHINE LEARNING




STRESS MANAGEMENT












INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO SENSATION SOFTWARE SOLUTIONS PVT. LTD., MOHALI
